I was notified by Chief Mickey Perry that a request had been submitted to locate the following items related to the Ray Minnerup case (CF-1995-55);

1. pair of scissors
2. Fingernail clippings - left and right
3. Brown paper sack placed over right hand
4. Brown paper sack placed over left hand
5. Known blood stain from driver
6. Known blood stain from Minnerup

The original letter you received from this department describing the items we had in evidence was incorrect. The evidence officer who provided the list of items did not open the cartons to see what was actually in our property room. The evidence officer used the information which was on the original property receipt (when items were first collected) and information from OSBI Lab returns.

Evidence Officer, Tammy Terneus and I located three cartons of evidence related to Case# CF-1995-55. We opened each carton and found the following items;

four twenty dollar bills us currency from register
\$9.85 in change from register
latent lifts
one unopened 200ml bottle of tvarscki vodka
one dime, one quarter, one quarter,
samples of J. Driver blood,
scalp hair,
pubic hair,
vaginal swabs,

I did find documentation that shows some of the evidence in this case was sent to the Tarrant County Medical Examiner in Fort Worth Texas at the request of the Defendant-Raymond Eugene Minnerup. The following items were transferred on 03/11/97 to Ronald L. Singer of the Tarrant County Medical Examiner.

1. Blood sample from Jacqueline Kay Driver;
2. Dried and frozen samples of blood from Jacqueline Kay Driver;
3. Blood sample from Raymond Eugene Minnerup;
4. Dried and frozen samples of blood from Raymond Eugene Minnerup;
5. All blood taken from cash register including dried and frozen samples, swabs or any other blood taken in the investigation.


I have not found any documentation which shows the transferred evidence or results of any testing were returned to this department.

In reference to your request - at this time I do not know the whereabouts of Item 1 - "pair of scissors" and Item 2 "fingernail clippings - left and right". I do have Item 3 - "brown paper sack placed over right hand" and Item 4 - "brown paper sack placed over left hand". Item 5 - "known blood stain from Driver" and Item 6 - "known blood stain from Minnerup" are no longer in our possession (transferred).

I have made contact with the Tarrant County Medical Examiner's office and left messages for Ronald L. Singer (817-920-5700, Ext 176); I have not received a reply from that office. I made contact with the OSBI in an attempt to locate any of the items. At this time they were unable to locate any of them.

This department will cooperate in providing any of the items we have related to this case.
